PEANUT BUTTER SPIDER COOKIES

12 PEANUT BUTTER COOKIES
(STORE-BOUGHT OR HOMEMADE)
12 MINI REESE'S PEANUT BUTTER CUPS
1/4 CUP CHOCOLATE, MELTED
OPTIONAL: 24 MINI CANDY EYEBALLS




BAKE. BAKE FOR 8-10 MINUTES, OR UNTIL VERY LIGHTLY BROWNED ON THE BOTTOMS. REMOVE FROM OVEN AND LET REST ON PAN FOR 2 MINUTES. PLACE PEANUT BUTTER CUPS. PLACE THE PEANUT BUTTER CUPS ON TOP OF THE COOKIES WHILE THEY'RE STILL WARM. THEN ALLOW COOKIES TO COOL ON A COOLING RACK.

DECORATE LIKE SPIDERS. ONCE COOKIES HAVE COOLED, MELT THE CHOCOLATE IN A MICROWAVE SAFE BOWL. COOK IN 30 SECOND INCREMENTS, STIRRING IN BETWEEN UNTIL MELTED. THEN PLACE IN A ZIP TOP BAG TO DECORATE. SNIP OFF THE EDGE AND PLACE TWO DOTS ON TOP OF THE REESE'S. THEN ATTACH THE EYES. NEXT DRAW 4 LEGS ON EACH SIDE OF THE REESE'S. ALLOW CHOCOLATE TO HARDEN.


